

WHO ARE BRITISH GYMNASTICS?

British Gymnastics are the recognised National Governing Body for Gymnastics. They are a not-for-profit organisation who support the gymnastics community to create safe, welcoming and rewarding experiences that enable gymnasts to shine.

WHO NEEDS BRITISH GYMNASTICS MEMBERSHIP

As an affiliated club of British Gymnastics club, Jolly Gymnastics requires everyone taking part in a structured class within our main club (Jolly Tots Stage 2 or 3, or Jolly Gym) to become an individual member of British Gymnastics. Jolly Tots in our Stage 1 classes, where parents are responsible for their child/ren at all times, do not require British Gymnastics membership. In this case you will be covered by Jolly Gymnastics' Public Liability Insurance but may wish to become a British Gymnastics member in order to access Personal Accident cover.

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIP

'Pre-school' membership is available to gymnasts who are not in full-time education during the membership year (1st October 2023 to 30th September 2024), costing £15. 'Gymnast' membership is available for all school-aged gymnasts, costing £22.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO

To become a member, visit www.british-gymnastics.org then click **Membership: Join or Renew** and follow the instructions:

- You will need to select 'Parent/Guardian' in the 'About You' field, as the gymnast is aged under 16.
- The name of the club your little one is joining is Jolly Gymnastics.
- The type of gymnastics your little one is taking part in is 'Pre-school Gymnastics' if under school-age or otherwise 'General Gymnastics'.
- If your child already has British Gymnastics membership linked to another club or if as a parent you have another child on your British Gymnastics account, you may need to click 'Membership: Join or Renew' and then scroll down to select 'Add or change a club' or 'Add another child to a membership account'.
- You don't need to let us know your little one's BG membership account - once complete we'll be able to see them on our Club Portal.
